Request for pupil to carry his/her own medicine (Epipens and inhalers only)

From September 2012, Public Health Nurse will no longer be responsible for liaising with parents or drawing up the care plan for pupils with Epipens. Parents are required to keep school informed of any changes to their child's allergies and the management plan. Children are prescribed an Epipen at the hospital allergy clinic and will be given an individual care plan by a Specialist Nurse. From Sept 12 schools will be asked to request a copy of the individual care plan from parents directly. The Public Health Nurse will continue to offer advice and guidance on medical conditions and in the drawing up of individual health plans if required.
